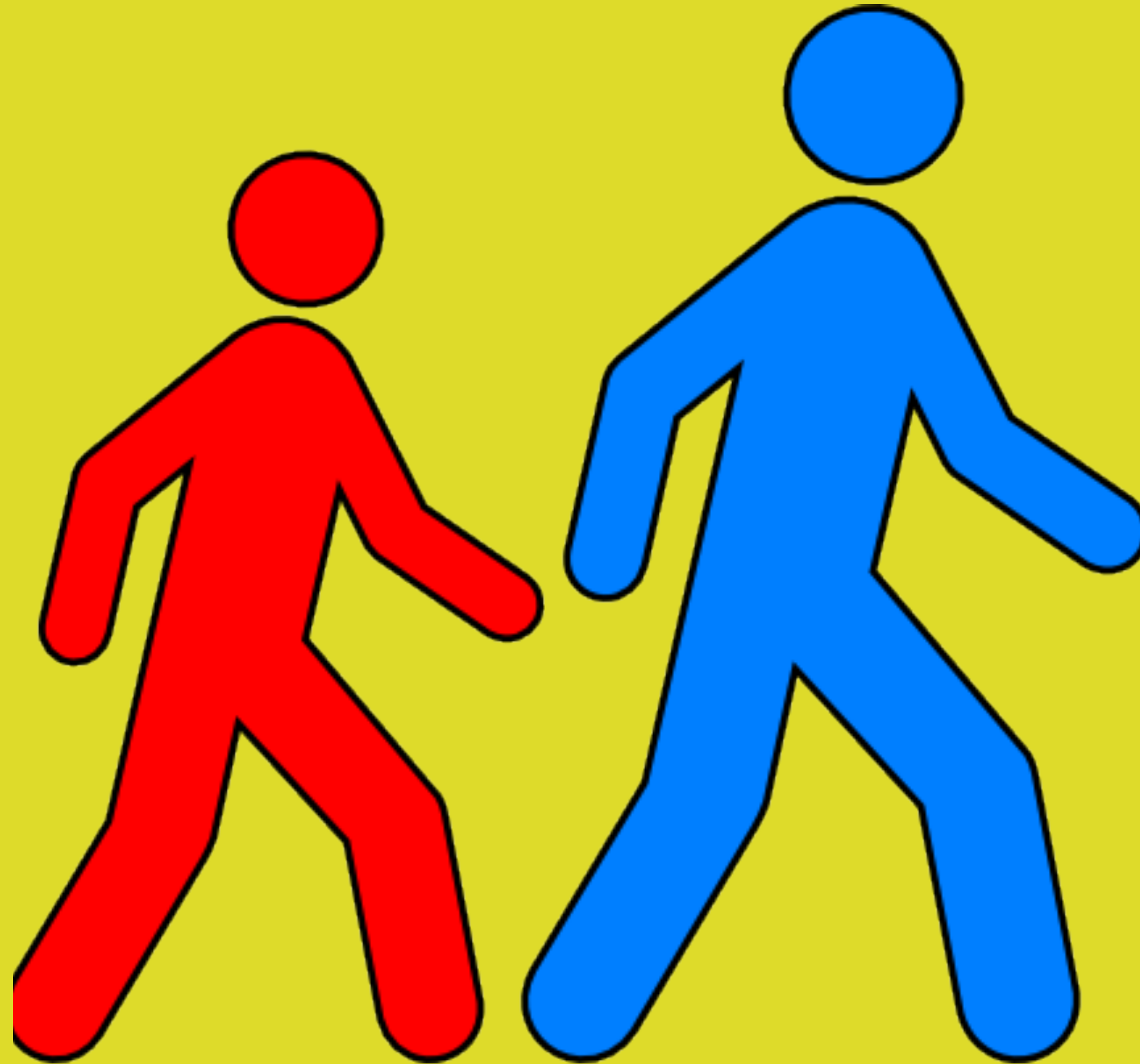
(i) developing my own walk with Jesus

Come, follow me,' Jesus said, 'and I will send you out to fish for people.'

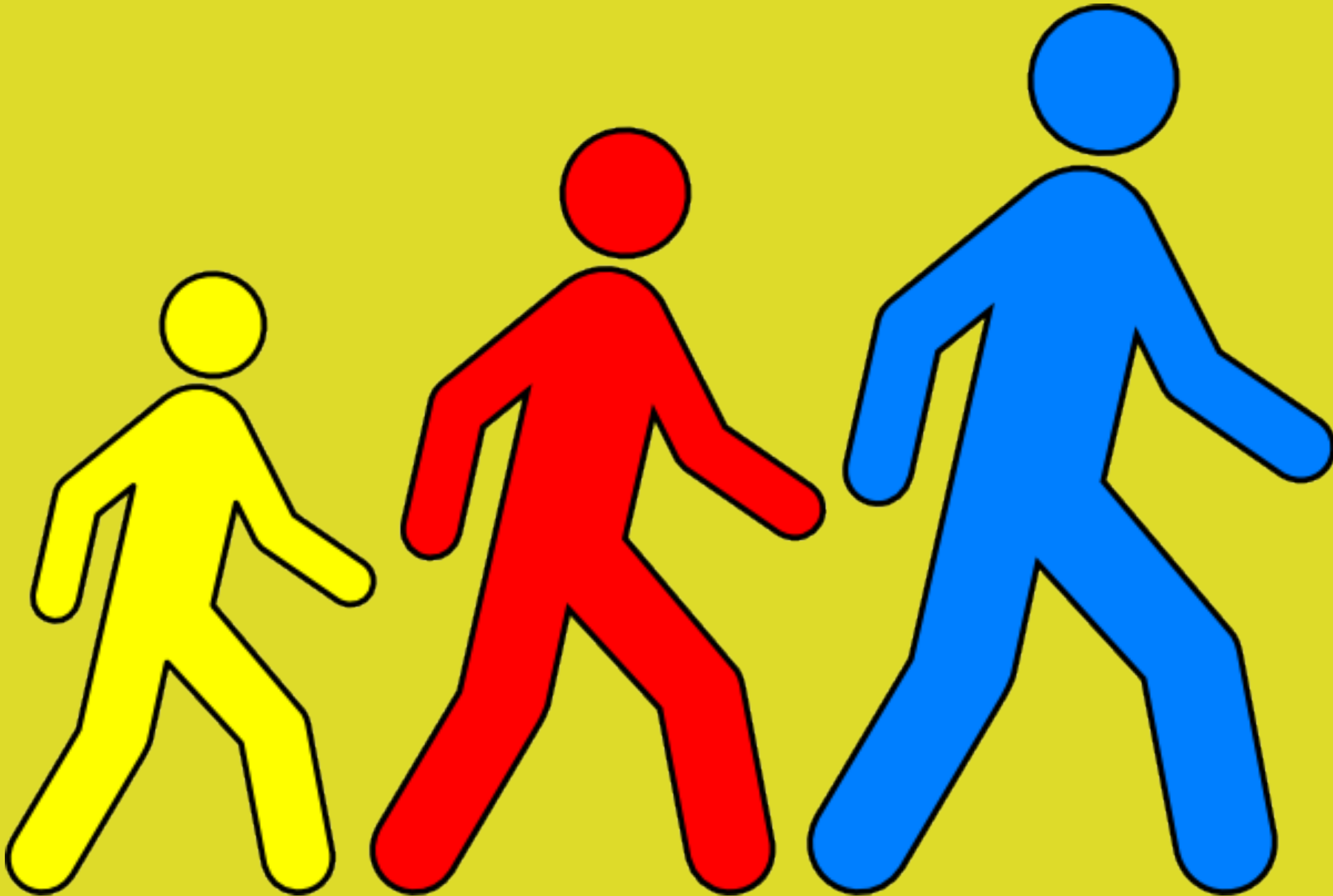

obey everything I have commanded you**



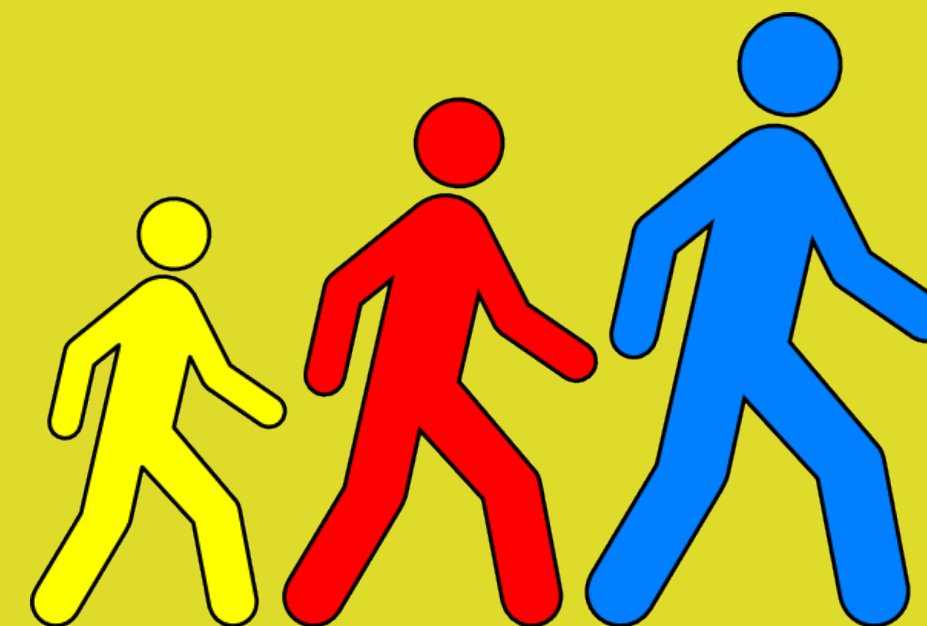
Discipling others



(ii) was the way of early church

2 Timothy 2:2

And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others.



Beginnings of discipleship



is to learn to LISTEN

John 10:3

The gatekeeper opens the gate for him, and the sheep listen to his voice. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out



Beginnings of discipleship



is to learn to LISTEN and DO what Jesus says

Luke 6:49

But the one who hears my words and does not put them into practice is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. The moment the torrent struck that house, it collapsed and its destruction was complete.'

John 8:28

So Jesus said, ‘When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am he and that I do nothing on my own but speak just what the Father has taught me.



Beginnings of discipleship



is to learn to LISTEN and DO what
Jesus says

John 14:10

Don't you believe that I am in the Father, and that the Father is in me? The words I say to you I do not speak on my own authority. Rather, it is the Father, living in me, who is doing his work.

OBSERVATION



Ask questions (the Spirit is at work)

- ★ what are you drawn to?
- ★ what does it make you think about?
- ★ what excites or troubles you?
- ★ What does it say about God, his people and/or life?
- ★ What are the promises, principles, commands or warnings?



APPLICATION



What is it (God) saying to me?

What am I going to do about it?

- ★ who can I share what I have learnt with?
- ★ Accountability: when will you talk about how they got on?
